Resolution R-83-06 authorizing and approving the additional allocation and expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$6.2 million for the purpose of paying the additional fees and costs associated with obtaining a guaranteed maximum price for the proposed new terminal at Myrtle Beach Int'l Airport. Mr. Frazier moved to approve, seconded by Mr. Hardee. Ms. Wright, Administration Division, spoke briefly on the history of the terminal project. Ms. Pat Apone, Airport Department, spoke briefly on the expenditure of the \$12.3 million. Doreen Frasca, Frasca & Associates, spoke briefly regarding the financing and debt of the project. Gary Lamb, Vice-President of Skanska USA Building and Project Executive, requested approval of the completion of the project design that would guarantee the maximum price. He also provided a breakdown of the additional \$6.2 million being spent to complete the design. Don Fowler, Fowler Communications and lobbyist for the Airport, spoke briefly about the process of securing \$43 million in federal funding for construction of the new terminal. John Napier, lobbyist for the Airport, reminded Council that the dollars were dwindling every day in

Washington. Mr. Knight spoke briefly stating that he and staff recommended approval of the resolution.

Chairman Gilland stated they had received a letter from Governor Sanford regarding a possible contribution of \$15 million from the State of South Carolina. She also announced a possible donation of \$10 million by a developer that was new to the area.
