Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Administrative Judge for General Sessions in the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, the following is hereby ORDERED:

All attorneys having criminal cases in the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit shall read and adhere to the directions and requirements of the Court as outlined below.

IT IS ORDERED that all requests for Orders of Protection from court appearances must be presented to the Chief Administrative Judge as outlined below:

- 1. Two hard copies of a proposed Order of Protection (one for Horry County and one for Georgetown County) shall be delivered to the Judge's Conway chambers, on which the attorney requesting protection certifies that (s)he has "examined the published rosters as of [date] and have no cases on those rosters and have no cases scheduled to be called on the dates requested", along with
- 2. A self-addressed stamped envelope for each separate Order (two envelopes if protection is requested in both counties).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of the proposed Order of Protection shall be sent to the Solicitor's Office. The Solicitor will have five (5) days from the date of receipt of the proposed Order to notify the Court, in writing, of any objection. After five (5) days, if the Judge has not received any objection, the proposed Order will be signed.
