It has come to the court's attention that Assistant Solicitor Chris Helms previously represented an unknown number of defendants whose cases are still pending in the $15^{\text {th }}$ Circuit. Concern has been raised that Mr. Helms may be privy to confidential information given to him while representing these defendants. The court has received no information that Mr. Helms has divulged confidential information and makes no such finding. However, out of an abundance of caution and to avoid even the appearance of any possible impropriety, I will recuse the $15^{\text {th }}$ Circuit Solicitor's Office from the prosecution of any case involving Mr. Helms' prior clients where the penalty involves the possibility of a life sentence or the death penalty. I reserve the right to further recuse the $15^{\text {th }}$ Circuit Solicitor's Office on other cases involving Mr. Helms' prior clients upon motion of defendant or his or her present attorney.
